



JUNE




In June, we joined two sustainable development talent pools: Impact Bread and Work For Good.

On Christmas 2020, Impact Bread launched the first sustainable talent pool, based on 17 United Nations Sustainable Development Goals (UN SDGs), to connect young Chinese people worldwide. And Work For Good is a social good recruitment platform incubated by CYCAN (China Youth Climate Action Network).

As a startup, it is hard for us to progress without their support in just a few months. During the pandemic, talent recruitment entered a new stage. And we are also making good use of this time to upgrade our human resources system and grow stronger.


